Community psychotherapy positions

Community-based clinical positions are available for licensed clinical social workers or psychologists who are fluent in Cantonese and interested in delivering psychotherapy to older adults in senior centers in Brooklyn NY.

Hired clinicians are expected to carry out outreach activities, engage senior center staff and clients, and deliver psychotherapy to clients at the senior centers. A clinician should be able to work at least two days per week.

In addition to direct services, clinicians participate in a weekly supervision and a weekly meeting. They are expected to run one outreach activity or group (structured engagement) per week (per center) and spend one hour per week in active unstructured engagement. These non-clinical hours will be paid (4 hours per week for a two-day work week).

In addition, clinicians are expected to have a minimum of three billable sessions per day at the site. Work hours are during senior center hours. All psychotherapy sessions are documented in the Weill Cornell EMR (EPIC) and all engagement activities are documented in Peer Place (DFTA) via computer.

No relocation assistance is provided for this position. Visa sponsorship is not available for this position. Weill Cornell Medical College is an employer and educator recognized for valuing AA/EOE/M/F/Protected Veterans, and Individuals with Disabilities.
