

3 ways to REGISTER to vote

Register online

Register by mail (postmarked by October 9 and received by October 14)

- If you do not have a printer, you can call by phone (866) 868-3692 to request a registration form, or email vote@boe.nyc.ny.us

Register in person at your borough Board of Elections office (by October 9)

- Exception: October 24 is last day to register, as a military voter, a spouse/dependent of someone in the military, if you were honorably discharged from military, or have become a naturalized U.S. citizen after October 9



After you have registered to vote, there are many ways to VOTE on or before November 3, 2020.

Be sure to research and learn about the candidates on the ballot before going to vote.

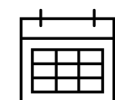
Vote in Person on November 3

- Poll Site Locator + sample ballot

- First time voters who did not provide identification when registering, need to provide: Photo ID, or recent copy of utility bill/bank statement/paycheck



Early Voting (October 24 to November 1)

- This is a great option if you can go in person, to avoid crowded lines, and to ensure your vote is counted without burdening the postal service.



Absentee ballot

- All registered voters in New York can vote by absentee ballot due to “temporary illness” including the risk of contracting COVID-19.
- Apply online (**by October 27 but preferably earlier**) and track your ballot: <https://vote.nyc>
 - **Call** (866) 868-3692 to request an application for absentee ballot
 - **Apply in person** for absentee ballot (by November 2) at local Board of Elections Office <https://vote.nyc/page/contact-us>
 - **Email PDF** of absentee application (by October 27) to: Apply4Absentee@boe.nyc
- You may **return** the ballot in the following 4 ways:
 - **Mail it**, postmarked no later than November 3 and be received no later than November 10 (but due to USPS delays – send in preferably 2 weeks in advance!)
 - **Drop it off at an early voting poll site** between October 24th and November 1
 - **Drop it off at a poll site** on November 3, by 9pm
 - **Drop it off at your local Board of Elections Office** as soon as you complete it, but no later than November 3 by 9pm
